Milwaukie Arts Committee Recycling on the Runway Trashion Show September 7th, 2024

Arrive at 12:00 noon to register and the Show begins at 12:30

Open to individuals or teams (maximum of 3 people per team eligible for one prize). Registration must be submitted **online or in person** to the Milwaukie Arts Committee at the front desk at City Hall no later than Friday, August 30th at 1PM.

<u>Materials Allowed:</u> Outfits must be made from recycled, upcycled or repurposed materials. No NEW materials should be purchased to create your outfit. Example: <u>no</u> new garbage bags or new items that <u>look</u> like trash will be allowed. Fasteners like safety pins and tape, etc. are OK but must constitute no more than 5% of the design. (NO hazardous materials, no glass, or sharp objects)

<u>Outfit Requirements:</u> Outfits must be wearable, have good lines of sight and the model must be able to move freely while wearing it.

Participants are encouraged to create accessories (hats, jewelry, bags, etc.) from recycled materials to complement their outfits, but this is not required.

The creator of the garment is not required to be the same person as the model, however; only the creator is eligible for prizes.

<u>Conduct and Safety</u>: <u>Safety is of utmost concern.</u> Keep this in mind when creating your design to allow safety in movement and again, do not include hazardous materials, or sharp, dangerous elements.

Respect and Inclusivity: Respect for all participants, judges and audience members is paramount. This event champions inclusivity and encourages diversity.

This is an outdoor event, and it may rain. Please plan accordingly.

Registration is in the tent behind the podium at the Sustainability Fair.

Please arrive no later than 12:00 noon, with the fashion show beginning at 12:30.

IMPORTANT: After initial introduction, entrants will return to the tent. Entrants may join in the "Trashion Walk" around the Sustainability Fair at the end or wait in front of the podium for judging.
