CONTEST CATEGORIES

- **Traditional or Contemporary Scarecrow:** Think outside the box and create a cutting-edge creation OR give us your interpretation of what you think of when you think 'scarecrow'.
- **Character Scarecrow:** Create a scarecrow based on your interpretation of your favorite movie, television character - human, animal or animated!
- **Group/Organization Scarecrow:** Create a scarecrow that represents your group!

TO ENTER THE CONTEST PLEASE FOLLOW THESE STEPS:

- **Pick up a prefabricated scarecrow stand** at City Hall (10501 SE Main St.) on one of the following dates. Supplies are limited to the first 20 participants. Stands will be provided on a first come, first served basis:
 - Monday, Sept. 9, 11 a.m. – 1 p.m.
 - Tuesday, Sept. 10, 5 p.m. – 7 p.m.
 - Wednesday, Sept. 11, 11 a.m. – 1 p.m.
 - *Please note: A \$20 cash deposit is required for all pickups. This deposit can be redeemed when the scarecrow stand is returned in its original condition with no extra screws, nails, paint, holes, staples, decorations or other defacement.*
- **Submit this entry form and your completed scarecrow on one of the following drop off dates:**
 - Monday, Sept. 30, 11 a.m. – 1 p.m.
 - Tuesday, Oct. 1, 6 – 8 p.m.

OFFICIAL RULES

- You must use a city-provided stand. Supplies are limited to the first 20 people who pick up stands during the dates listed above.
- Submit your completed entry form and scarecrow during one of the approved drop off periods listed above.
- Stands should not be damaged with paint, adhesives, screws, nails, or other means.
- All scarecrow contest entries will be staked into the ground in front of Historic City Hall (10722 SE Main St.)
- Scarecrows must be able to stand on the city-provided stands and may not touch the ground. No materials can be put on the ground under your scarecrow.
- Scarecrows must be weather resistant and sturdy to qualify for judging and displaying. No perishable goods may be used in the construction such as pumpkins, etc.
- No weapons or dangerous objects can be included on the scarecrows.
- During the display period, entries should be checked periodically, and any necessary repairs should be made.
- The Milwaukie Arts Committee reserves the right to photograph entries for promotional purposes. Photographs become the property of the Milwaukie Arts Committee.
- The City of Milwaukie and Milwaukie Arts Committee reserve the right to refuse any scarecrow entry that may be offensive to the public or that violates these contest rules.
- The City of Milwaukie and Milwaukie Arts Committee are not responsible for damage or vandalism to the scarecrows while on display.
