2.1 May 28, 2013, Joint Meeting with Planning Commission

Chair Hemer clarified that two DLC members had not participated in the May 28, 2013, DLC meeting.

Peter Watts, City Attorney, suggested that meeting attendees should make the motion and second the motion, and the remaining members should abstain.

DLC Member Chantelle Gamba moved to approve the May 28, 2013, meeting minutes as proposed. Chair Hemer seconded the motion. The minutes were approved 2-0-2, with DLC Members Sherry Grau and Val Ballestrem abstaining.

5.0 Public Meetings

5.1 Summary: Design Review of Veterinary Clinic Expansion

Chair Hemer called the meeting to order and read the conduct of design review meeting format into the record.

Li Alligood, **Associate Planner**, provided an overview of the staff report and recommendation via PowerPoint.

- The applicant proposed to construct three additions to the building.
- Because the building was located in the Downtown Residential zone DR, the additions triggered Type III Downtown Design Review.
- The applicant had also requested an exception to the design standards for roofs.

Alyssa Leeviraphan, Mahlum Architects, was available to answer questions.

- Chair Hemer asked if the concrete linear accelerator could be textured or covered with vinyl
 siding to match the rest of the building. Ms. Leeviraphan stated that it was possible but
 would add substantial cost to the addition.
- Chair Hemer asked what type of fence material would be used for the fenced dog area. Ms.
 Leeviraphan was uncertain, but noted that chain link had been discussed.
- **DLC Member Gamba** suggested the landscape architect review the downtown design guidelines before putting too much time into the design.

Chair Hemer closed the public testimony portion of the meeting.

The Committee discussed the proposal.

DLC Member Ballestrem moved to recommend approval of DR-13-05 and the recommended findings and conditions of approval. DLC Member Grau seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.
