1.0 Call to Order – Procedural Matters

2.1 October 7, 2013

 - 6.1 Summary: DLC Bylaws Update

Chair Hemer provided an overview of past discussions about the bylaws. The DLC had provided direction to staff regarding revisions to the bylaws, and the revised bylaws had been included in the packet.

Ms. Alligood provided an overview of the DLC's discussions about updating its bylaws. The Committee's adopted bylaws were sufficient but not ideal. **The Committee** had discussed the bylaws at its November meeting and provided direction regarding edits to the proposed draft bylaws. Ms. Alligood pointed out items that had been revised since the November discussion.

Chair Hemer led a discussion about the proposed revisions to the bylaws. **The Committee** determined which edits they wanted to retain.

Ms. Alligood noted that the next step would be to request that Council adopt the revised bylaws.

Mr. Egner suggested the group continue to consider goals for discussion with Council, and provided an overview of the Council's adopted goals for 2014.

DLC Member Grau moved to approve the revised bylaws as amended during the discussion. DLC Member Ballestrem seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.
