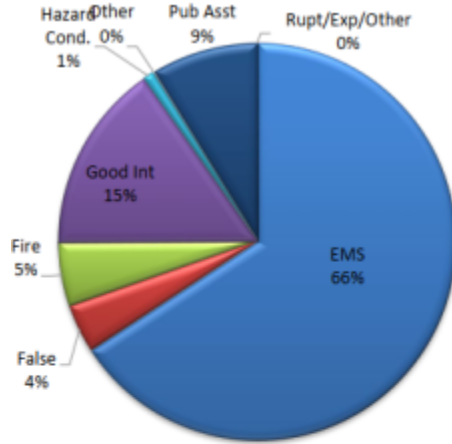

 - Station 22 Open House (Gladstone Fire Station): Saturday, September 28th from 10:30am-12:30pm.
 - Station 17 Open House (South End Road Fire Station): Saturday, October 12th from 1pm-3pm.
- Levy update
 - 24/7 career staffing at Clarkes Fire Station #13 started July 1st, 2024
 - Rescue unit (quick response vehicle) assigned to Station 1 (24/7 staffing)
 - 24/7 career staffing at Logan Fire Station #12 in summer of 2025
 - A new academy of 15 firefighters starts in September to further support and enhance response within the community while also backfilling positions opened through attrition.
- Other District Info:
 - The Pacific Northwest is experiencing a high volume of wildfires this year and Oregon is no exception. The Fire District has resources out helping with these wildfires all over Oregon. As of 8/12, we have apparatus and personnel deployed to: the Dixon Fire, Town Gulch Fire, Diamond Complex, and Elk Lane Fire. Please be extra cautious.
 - Backyard burning is closed for the season. This will reopen in October weather dependent.

- Safety Message:
 - This month's focus is on emergency preparedness, water safety, and pedestrian safety.
 - Emergency Preparedness: September is Emergency Preparedness Month. Everyone is encouraged to consider the wide range of emergencies that could impact them and their community. Make sure to have evacuation plans, emergency supplies at home (minimum of 72 hr), go bag for leaving home quickly, etc. Consider taking the CERT basic class starting October 19th, register at: <https://milwaukiepsf.org/course-registration/>
 - Water Safety: Use extreme caution in and around the water, especially rivers. Even in shallow waters, currents can be unpredictable and dangerous. Always use life jackets around water. Swimmers need to be aware of their surroundings and to never dive into shallow or unknown water.
 - Pedestrian Safety: With the summer weather comes increased outdoor activity. Drivers need to be aware of pedestrians. Also, schools begin back in late August/early September so be aware of children walking to and from school.
